COVID-19 ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Under the current Public Health Order, the following requirements **MUST** be observed prior to and during the visit to Sacred Heart Cathedral. Thank you for your assistance in helping to keep everyone safe and secure during the continuing COVID-19 pandemic event.

Please note: A maximum of ten (10) people are permitted within the Cathedral at any time.

Please follow the directions of the Sacristan on duty, who will be monitoring the numbers in the Cathedral. The Sacristan is my delegate for monitoring compliance with the requirements associated with entry to the Cathedral.

Before you enter the Cathedral:

1. You must provide your contact details on the form provided for this purpose. This information will be kept by the Cathedral Rector for a period of four weeks and can only be used for contact tracing if necessary.
2. You are requested to use the hand sanitiser provided – and to use it on the way out of the Cathedral as well.

During your visit to the Cathedral:

1. You must observe the suggested physical distancing requirements within the Cathedral.
2. If you are required to queue for entry to the Cathedral, you must observe the required physical distancing requirements.
3. You must refrain from physical acts of devotion towards any religious item within the Cathedral (including statues, icons, etc.).
