

## PHASE 2 REOPENING: ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

### THE CATHEDRAL IS OPEN

From Monday **18 October 2021**, Sacred Heart Cathedral is open for both the public celebration of Mass and other liturgies, and for private prayer and meditation.

# MAXIMUM CAPACITY 110 PERSONS

### **REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY**

- 1. You are required to provide your contact details using either:
  - a. the SERVICE NSW QR Code available at the entrance, or
  - b. via the paper-based contact details form available at the entrance.
- 2. You are requested to make use of the hand sanitiser provided as you enter the Cathedral.
- 3. You are required to always wear a face mask while in the Cathedral unless you have an exception or exemption under the public health order.
- 4. You must observe the required physical distancing requirements within the Cathedral, including while part of a queue or procession, keeping 1.5m from other people. Members of the same household are not required to observe this requirement.
- 5. You are asked to refrain from physical acts of devotion towards religious items (statues, icons, etc.) within the Cathedral. This includes touching, kissing or any other form of devotion.
- 6. You must follow the directions of members of the clergy or Cathedral staff.
- 7. You must observe the requirements of the public health order currently in place.
- 8. You are asked to observe the best advice made available by NSW Health to ensure the safety and health of other attendees.

### **COVID VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS**

Except under very limited circumstances, it is <u>not necessary</u> to be fully vaccinated to enter the Cathedral.

All parishioners and visitors to the Cathedral are encouraged to receive the COVID-19 vaccination in order to protect themselves and others.
